





●Clothes

(Do not remove buttons and zippers)

- Shirts, Suits, Trousers, Skirts,
- Underwears, Sweaters, Coats,
- Jumpers, Socks,
- Neckties, Kimonos, Obi

●Cloth

- Sheets, Towel, Curtains, Laced curtain,
- Blankets,

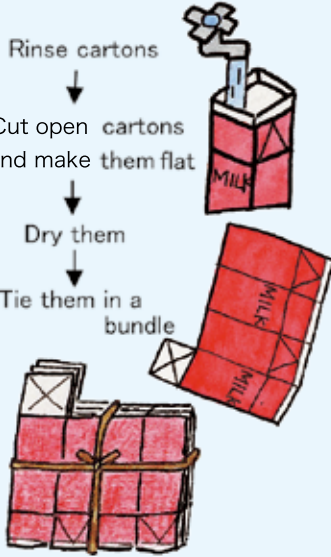
● Wash, dry and fold them

- If it is raining, do not dispose of them or put them in a clear plastic bag



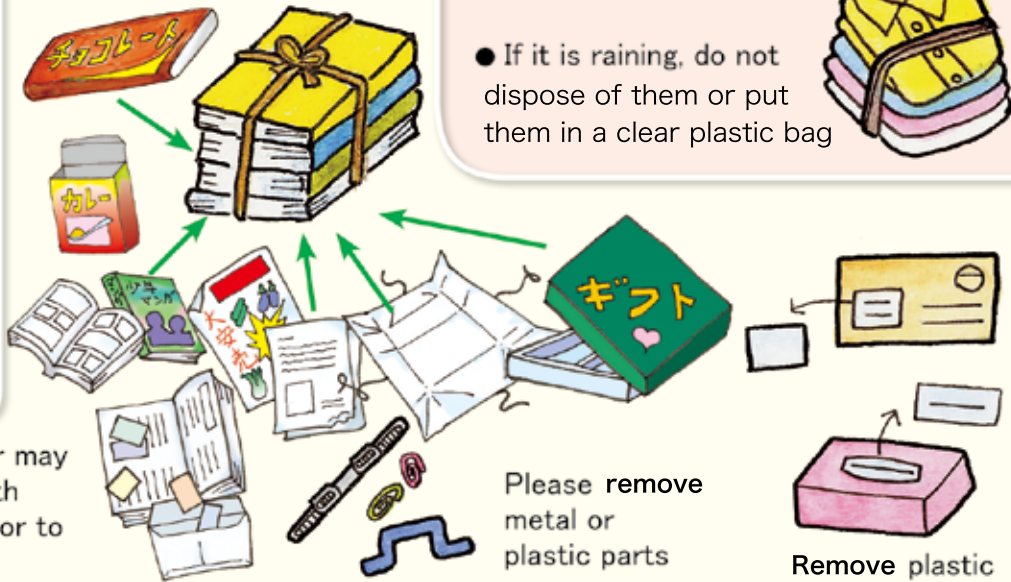
●Milk cartons

- Rinse cartons
- ↓
- Cut open cartons and make them flat
- ↓
- Dry them
- ↓
- Tie them in a bundle



●Magazines, Scrap papers

- Books, Notebooks, Newspaper ad-inserts, Postcards, Letters, Paper boxes, Wrapping papers, Envelopes, Memo papers etc



Small pieces of paper may be easy to bundle with magazines or leaflets or to insert in an envelope

Please remove metal or plastic parts

Remove plastic

Please do not put it out on a rainy day. If you have to put the garbage out unavoidable, put it in a clear plastic bag.

Items that you cannot dispose of (Example)

These things are not suitable for recycling. Dispose of the garbage below as burnable garbage



Paper that is covered by oil and food (ex. pizza boxes, cake boxes)



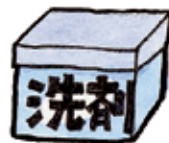

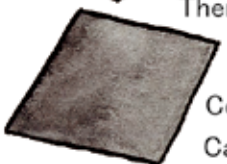

How to Dispose of Bottles, Cans and PET Bottles

How to dispose of bottles, cans and PET bottles

Bottles, Cans : Put in yellow net or container.

PET Bottles : Put in blue net.



The lid and labels should be disposed of as plastic containers and packaging.

The metal lid should be disposed as Non-Burnable Waste.

Take off the lid and rinse the inside.

How to Dispose of Burnable Garbage

It is the garbage that the Sanitary Association defined as "burnable"

Disposable Burnable Garbage (Example)



* Specified bag is unnecessary.



Tree branches, twigs

* The items should be no bigger than 30cm in length and 6 cm in thickness : Bind them with strings.

* Please absorb used cooking oil in paper or cloth, or use a solidifying agent before disposal.

Caution



Put the burnable garbage in the specified bags. Garbage placed in other bags (paper bags, cardboard boxes) will not be collected.

Please call for an appointment early.

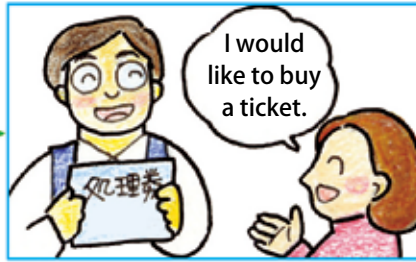

① Make reservation by phone
(Bulky Waste Reservation Center 31-8286)

Maximum amount: 5 items per one collection



② Purchase tickets for the collection
at the stores listed below for
550 yen per ticket



③ Put out your bulky items with the
ticket attached on the designated date
at the designated place

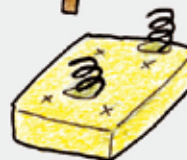

(Exception: Be sure to call in advance and make an appointment.)
- Since the Bulky Waste Tickets cannot be peeled off once they are attached, make sure you attach them properly.
- If you dispose of bulky waste, please insure to put your name and the collection date.
- The Bulky Waste Tickets cannot be used for televisions, washing machines, refrigerators or air conditioners
